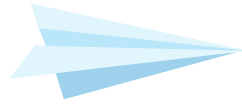

WHY CPD?

The REIQ's continuing professional development (CPD) program is the accreditation system used for membership. Every year REIQ Individual Members must earn at least 100 points to

remain eligible.

WHAT CONSTITUTES CPD?

If you attend training or seminars run outside of the REIQ, you are able to apply for up to 50 CPD points. Please email cpd@reiq.com.au to apply.

WHEN IS CPD AVAILABLE?

- † 100 points need to be earned every calendar year
- † REIQ offers online options at all times
- † CPD sessions are held as part of REIQ zone events, which are usually scheduled from February to December.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

IS CPD COMPULSORY FOR MY MEMBERSHIP?

Yes. If you do not earn 100 points by 31 December 2019 your eligibility for REIQ membership may be audited. If you're not able to supply satisfactory evidence of CPD training, your membership may be suspended and may be cancelled.

HOW DO I APPLY TO HAVE POINTS AWARDED FOR NON-REIQ TRAINING?

The REIQ recognises more external training than ever before. Many non-REIQ courses, events and activities may be eligible for REIQ CPD points. To be acceptable they must relate to the real estate profession in Queensland, and contain practical educational content. To apply for CPD points for any non-REIQ training please get in touch with us via cpd@reiq.com.au.

EXEMPTIONS

If you believe you should not be required to undertake CPD (due to extenuating circumstances or prolonged study) you can apply for an exemption. Contact cpd@reiq.com.au for more information.

WHAT IF I EARN MORE THAN 100 POINTS?

Congratulations - you may be acknowledged in the REIQ Journal as one of our CPD high-achievers! Please note that excess points cannot be carried over to future year/s.

CAN I CLAIM POINTS FOR A LICENCE UPGRADE?

Sales people and property managers may claim CPD points for study undertaken towards obtaining a real estate licence for the CPD year during which the study was undertaken and completed.
