Protocols for prospective buyers and tenants

Pursuant to restrictions implemented from 1am Tuesday 29 June for people living in South East Queensland and best practice directions issued by the REIQ, the following protocols must be observed by anyone entering the property. Failure to comply with these requirements may result in entry being denied or immediate cancellation of the inspection.

30 PEOPLE MAXIMUM

Inside the property at one time, *inclusive* of the agent.



SOCIAL DISTANCING

Please keep 1.5m apart and allow 4m² space per person.



HANDS FREE & WEAR A MASK

Do not touch anything during the inspection. You must wear a mask indoors and in spaces you cannot socially distance.

Inspections are contactless (no paper brochures or contract information) everything digital

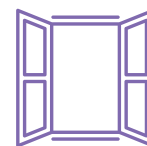
